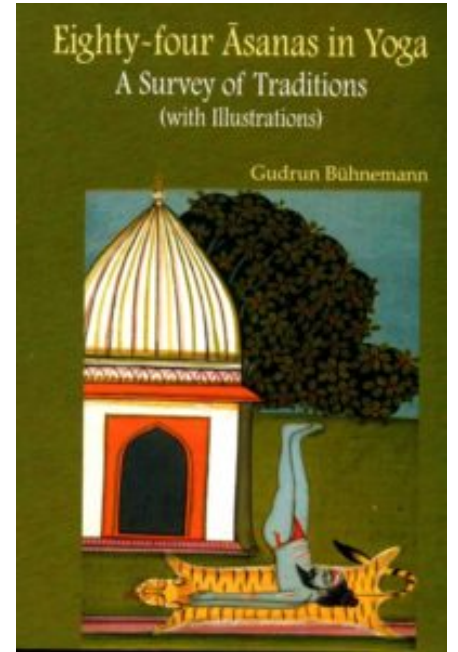


# Prof. Gudrun Bühnemann
